



A mass gathering is defined as an event where a large number of people come together at a particular location for a specific purpose. Such locations, usually associated with large crowds, could always be an attractive target for terrorists.

Why are mass gatherings attractive?

High casualty potential

The presence of a dense crowd may increase the potential number of casualties.

Soft targets

Open spaces and sometimes with limited security measures in terms of the scale and complexity of these gatherings.

Symbolic significance

Mass gatherings may represent certain important symbols, values or ideologies, e.g. a religious gathering which bears religious significance, or a concert that bears certain cultural value.

🔐 Economic or political impact

Terrorist attacks on mass gatherings may inflict economic damage and undermine public confidence, e.g. creating a perception of instability and actual instability in the targeted area and causing disruption to business activities.

Media and international attention

Extensive media coverage and international attention may amplify the impact of an attack, spread fear and provide opportunities for terrorists to further their agenda.

Overseas attacks targeting mass gatherings

Russia

In March 2024, several gunmen launched a mass shooting attack at a popular concert venue in Moscow, Russia, resulting in over 140 deaths and over 550 injuries.



The US

In April 2024, several gunmen staged a shooting attack at a park in West Philadelphia, where about 1,000 people had gathered for Eid al-Fitr (an Islamic religious celebration marking the end of Ramadan).



In May 2017, a man conducted a suicide bombing attack at Manchester Arena in Manchester, the UK. Following a concert by an American pop singer, he detonated an improvised explosive device containing triacetone triperoxide (TATP) and nuts and bolts serving as shrapnel, resulting in 22 deaths and more than 1,000 injuries.

- ▶ Take notice of your surroundings and identify potential emergency exit routes
- ▶ Beware of unusual behaviours, unattended objects, unexplained odours, or vehicles travelling at an abnormal speed or pattern
- Report any suspicious persons, items or activities to security personnel or the Police

Take Action - Run, Hide, Report

When an attack or emergent incident occurs, remember to:



Remain Vigilant



Stay alert for potential secondary attacks



Render first aid when safe to do so



When emergency services personnel arrive, follow their instructions
